

Flower Mound Community Orchestras Spring Concerts

The Flower Mound Symphony Orchestra presents “Russian Spring”, a concert featuring an internationally renowned pianist, Eduardo Rojas, on Saturday, March 7 at 7:30 p.m. The diverse program will include *Selections from Fireworks* (Handel), *March Slav* (Tchaikovsky), *Outdoor Overture* (Copland) and *Piano Concerto No. 2* (Rachmaninoff), featuring Rojas, who appeared at FMSO’s 2014 Patriotic concert with the orchestra. He will be performing on the Bösendorfer 225 piano from Collora Piano Company, which promises to provide an evening of beautiful music. Prior to the concert, 6:45 to 7:15, FMSO’s Music Director, Esteban Rojas will provide an informal lecture with discussion in the ministry center. Performances are held at Trietsch Memorial United Methodist Church, 6101 Morriss Road in Flower Mound. There will be a post-concert Meet & Greet with Music Director Estéban Rojas & piano soloist Eduardo Rojas in the Connection center immediately following the concert. As with all concerts by the F.M.C.O., admission is free and donations are gratefully accepted.
