The organization consists of the Symphony, Preparatory and Philharmonic orchestras which provide a venue for both adult and young people who desire to express their love of music in their community. About our organization: The Flower Mound Symphony Orchestra was founded in June of 1994 to provide area residents a vehicle for the performance and enjoyment of classical music. Our mission is to encourage and instruct musicians in the art of orchestral presentation and promote music education and awareness in the community. The orchestra is composed of local-area musicians who volunteer their time and considerable talents for the benefit of cultural awareness in the community and for their own enjoyment of playing in an ensemble. The Preparatory and Philharmonic Orchestras prepare adults and young people to join the larger group as they become more proficient or renew their musical expertise. The Flower Mound Community Orchestra and its ensembles are available to play at community events and functions around the Flower Mound/Lewisville/Highland Village area.
